

Program Impact

Workshops-Over 1,000 students and job seekers gained valuable aviation and aerospace industry insight and career information.

Mentoring—Over 75 aviation and aerospace industry leaders participated in workshops, met with students and job seekers to understand interests and challenges, and provided keen career advice.




